

Privacy policy pursuant to section 13 of the legislative decree 196/2003

Our privacy policy is drafted pursuant to section 13 of legislative decree 196/2003 (the "Privacy Code").

Users are free to provide the personal data. However, failure to provide such data may entail the failure to be provided with the items requested.

Personal data provided by the user are processed, alternatively, depending on the selected service, for:

- (1) submitting newsletter, commercial information, special offers and promotional material relating to Fox via e-mail, regular mail, SMS, phone;
- (2) providing commercial and/or technical information related to Fox *brand* upon user's request, specifically detailed information of Fox products, authorized assistance and sale centers in Italy and worldwide. Such information can be requested by the user by compiling the form accessible through the section "Reserved Area" and section "Contact us" on the site www.fox-machines.com.

The data controller is the Femi S.p.A., with registered office in Via del Lavoro 4 - z.i. Poggio Piccolo - 40023 Castel Guelfo (BO) - ITALY, (the "Data Controller").

The processing operations related to the purposes n. (1) and (2) above are carried out at the aforementioned office of the Data Controller exclusively by technical staff in charge of said processing, or else by persons providing such maintenance services on computer systems as may be necessary from time to time, which will be previously appointed data supervisor pursuant to section 29 of the Privacy Code.

No data processed are either communicated or disseminated.

Personal data are processed with automated means for the time necessary to achieve the purposes for which they have been collected. Specific security measures are implemented to prevent the data from being lost, used unlawfully and/or inappropriately, and accessed without authorization.

Pursuant to section 7 of the Privacy Code, data subjects are entitled at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning them and be informed of their contents and origin, of the purposes and means of the processing activity, of the logic applied in case the processing is made with automated means, of the basic information necessary to identify the Data Controller, the persons in charge of the processing, the data supervisor, or the persons to which data can be communicated and that act as data supervisors or persons in charge of the processing. Data subjects are also entitled to verify data accuracy, or request that such data be supplemented, updated or rectified. Data subjects are also entitled to ask for data cancellation, transformation into anonymous form, or for the block of data processed by infringing the law, including those for which the conservation is not necessary in consideration of the purposes of the processing. Moreover, data subjects are entitled to obtain declaration relating to operation of updating, rectification, integration, cancellation and transformation stating that these operation are communicated, even for what concern their contents, to whom data have been communicated or transferred, unless such fulfillment is not possible or implies burdensome means. Finally, data subjects are entitled to oppose for lawful reasons to data processing, to oppose to data processing for marketing purposes or sale purposes, market researches or commercial advertising.
